Application Video Questions Video Sharing Instructions

Record a video of yourself answering each of these three questions to the camera:

1. Without naming a specific name, please describe the person that has most influenced you to become an educator, and how they influenced you.
2. If your greatest supporter was in the room with us today, what five words would he or she use to describe you as a person, a student, or a peer?
3. Why do you want to become a music educator, and why do you feel that you are uniquely qualified to attend FMES?

Video Guidelines

- Your video must be between 3-4 minutes long.
- Be professional and personable. Let your personality come through while still treating the application video with a professional demeanor.
- Address each of the three questions thoroughly - specific and thoughtful examples help the selection committee get an accurate glimpse of you personally and as a future music educator.

If your video is saved to a desktop or laptop computer...

1. Sign in to your YouTube account (a parent or teacher's account may be used if needed) and click the Upload link at the top of any YouTube page.
2. Select "Unlisted" from the dropdown menu.* Name your video with your first and last name as it will appear in the RNS system when your teacher nominates you.
3. Click on the Upload button, browse for your video file, select the file you want to upload and click Open.
4. Once the upload is complete, click "Done" to confirm, and copy the video's URL to e-mail or share with your nominating teacher. Please be sure to copy the share URL and not the URL at the top of the webpage.
5. Your nominating teacher will then copy that URL into the FMES application/nomination page in RNS.

If your video is saved to a mobile device....

1. Tap the "Share" option on your device and select YouTube.
2. When the app opens for your upload, name the upload with your first and last name and select "Unlisted" from the menu toward the bottom of the screen.*
3. Click the "Publish" or "Send" button to upload the video to the YouTube account.
4. Once it has uploaded, send the video's URL to your nominating teacher. Please be sure to use the share URL and not the URL at the top of a YouTube webpage.

** Please Note: By setting your video to "Unlisted," only people who know the link/URL of the video can view it. An Unlisted video will not appear in any of YouTube's public spaces such as search results, your channel, or the Browse page, so your privacy will be protected.*
